Title of Sermon: In Conclusion

Passage: Jude 24-25 NIV

Intro -

1. What are the most important things you have learned during this series in the book of Jude?
2. How has studying this book changed or affirmed the way you have thought about false teaching?
3. What questions do you still have about false teaching that you would love to have answered? How would you and your group currently answer those questions?

Sermon Points -

1. God Guards
 - a. Do you believe someone can lose their salvation? Why or why not?
 - b. How does reading Romans 8:28-39, Ephesians 1:13-14, and John 10:22-30 affect your answer to the previous question? If you believe you can lose your salvation, how do you best explain the meaning of these passages?
 - c. How does the fact that “those God calls, he keeps” affect your understanding of your friends and family who are currently wandering from the faith in some manner? How does it affect the way you can pray for them?
 - d. How have you seen God intervene in your own life in order to keep you in the faith or keep you away from spiritual danger?
2. God’s Goal
 - a. Why does God save people? What are his purposes?
 - b. Can you be a true believer in Jesus and not exhibit some kind of growth in Christ-likeness? Why or why not? Can you marshal some Scriptural evidence for your view?
 - c. How much “holiness” is necessary for a person to be considered a true believer?
 - i. Why do some Christians grow more than others in this life?
 - ii. Does it matter how much a believer grows as long as there is some growth?
 - d. How does knowing God’s goal is to make us holy affect our understanding of our circumstances?
 - i. Explain how a passage like Hebrews 12:4-11 helps answer this question.
 - e. How has God been “chiseling” you lately?
