 - a. Why do we struggle extending forgiveness to those who sin against us?
 - b. What do the scriptures teach about forgiveness? (Read a few passages)
 - c. In what ways have we (corporately) sinned against others?
- 3. What's the difference between a trial and a temptation?
 - a. What examples from your own experience can you use to show the difference between testing and temptation?
 - b. In what ways is God currently testing you?
 - c. Spend some time praying for each other, bearing each other's burdens
